Information on the conference

Dear Colleagues and Friends,

We (gladly) look forward to our tenth conference with more than 50 researchers presenting a paper. (Therefore, presentations should not be longer than 20 minutes while PhD students are asked to shorten their paper for 15 minutes. Thanks.)

You will find the preliminary program enclosed. Hungarian presenters are asked to prepare foreign language presentation and handouts.

The venue of the conference is the assembly hall and the theatre hall of Eszterházy Károly College, building „A”. Eszterházy tér 1. On 3 Sept, the venue is the castle of Edelény.

Travelling to Eger

By coach: probably the most convenient way of transport from Budapest. The coach station is right next to „Stadionok” station of METRO line 2; there is a coach in every 15 minutes (XX.00, XX.15, XX.30, XX.45, etc.).

By train: trains leave from KELETI STATION (= pályaudvar). One can reach it by METRO line 2 and also 4 (both stations called also „Keleti pályaudvar”). Trains leave at 7.00, 9.00, 11.00, 13.00, 15.00, 17.00 (duration: 1 hour 50 min), and at 19.00 (2 hours 25 min); timetables may change, please check it.

From the airport: unfortunately, there is only a complicated public transport to the city (with 3 changes).

Airport shuttle: 3200 HUF/person to the centre.

Taxi: take the official taxi („Főtaxi) which costs about 6-8000 HUF to the centre (check the taxi-meter!);

Parking in Eger: private cars may park in front of the „B” building of the college, and, a limited number may park at „A” building.

Accommodation. All hotels and hostels are in the centre of Eger, within 5–10 minutes walk of the conference venue. PhD students may stay in students’ hostels, 15 min walk from the venue.
